The All-America Concert Band was organized in September of 1990 by Michael Hogan to provide adult musicians an opportunity to perform in public. Since 1990, the band has developed a more complete instrumentation and has become a very active part of the musical life of the Siouxland community.

The band is a very unique organization in that every performance is a benefit for a qualifying non-profit 501c3 organization. Because of generous corporate support they receive from area businesses, 100% of the funds raised from the sale of concert tickets is given to their beneficiaries and we have been able to raise thousands of dollars which are reinvested in our communities to make them a better place in which to live.

The name "All-America Concert Band" is associated with the fact that Sioux City was named an "All-America City" in 1990 because of the city's astounding response to the crash of United Airlines Flight 232 in 1989. The members of the Band elected to use that as a part of the Band's name and "Siouxland, USA" indicates that the Band's membership is comprised of persons from the Siouxland region and not just Sioux City. Although one is tempted to put an "n" at the end of All-America that is not the case. They are "The All-America Concert Band" - and proud of it!

Divine Mercy Conference A Huge Success!

Saturday, October 1, 2011 was an absolutely beautiful day with the sunshine, calm winds and perfect blue skies. The registrants began arriving shortly before 7:00a.m., which was an early indication the conference was to be well attended. There were 260 adults and 61 youth that were in attendance for the 2nd Midwest Divine Mercy Marian Conference.

Father Donald Calloway, MIC held the audience spellbound as he told his story of his conversion from being a high school dropout, with a trouble family life, who had been kicked out of a foreign country, institutionalized twice and thrown in jail multiple times.

Father Donald Calloway was raised without any religion or a good father figure. When his family moved to California, he slipped into the "MTV lifestyle" - sex, drugs and rock music. This pagan rebellion intensified to total mayhem when his family relocated to Japan and he ran away from home. Constantly on the move to avoid arrest, he and his friends soon got

connected with the Japanese Mafia. During his time of endless wanton wandering filled with wine, women & song, Donald's mother became Catholic & fervently prayed for her fifteen-year-old prodigal son to return home.

Fortunately, he discovered a book on Marian apparitions and devoured its powerful message of repentance. The Blessed Virgin Mary had literally stolen his heart and introduced spiritual concepts like heaven, hell, repentance and sin.

Supplementing the key note speaker was Joan and Dave Maroney who left behind successful careers and the comfort of home for the sake of the New Evangelization called for by Pope John Paul II. They told the story of how they are dedicating their lives to spreading the authentic message of Divine Mercy and devotion to Our Lady.

Dr Bryan Thatcher, MD founder of Eucharistic Apostles of Divine Mercy spoke on the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, the

message of Divine Mercy as a "Way of Life and his personal conversion.

The youth were treated to a special session by Father David Hemann of the Diocese of Sioux City. He has been engaged in a music ministry before and throughout his priesthood. His skill is relating to the youth through his ministry and those in attendance were very active in the session. The response from those in attendance was most positive.

The Conference concluded with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass at the Cathedral of the Epiphany celebrated by Bishop R. Walker Nickless of the Sioux City Diocese. The church was filled and the music echoed the voices of the conference attendees with a special joyous sound.

The evening ceremonies were back at the Sioux City Convention Center with a fund raising dinner for the Queen of Peace, Inc. The speakers were able to visit with those in attendance in a very relaxed atmosphere and all were treated to a

These students were an example of what service day is all about. They really put in a good days effort. What a great group of kids!

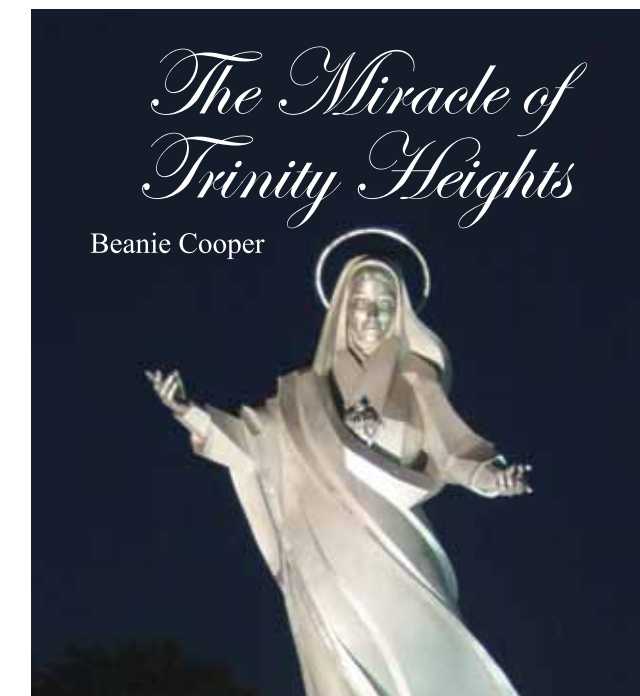
VETERAN MEMORIAL HAS A HOME AT TRINITY HEIGHTS
